- Fire Master Plan first draft under revision and at peer review stage
- Chief's Truck ordered, expected delivery July
- Mandatory certification training ongoing on pace
- Thorndale Station saw several promotions (District Chief W. Fox, District Deputy Chief R. Kuenzlen, Captain K. Rogers), 5 new Firefighter recruits hired (start date of April 8) * Training officer and Captain position vacancies to fill 2nd guarter
- TCFD Chief's meeting held Mar 22
- All capital projects initiated/ordered/received/completed
- Regular meetings with Mutual Aide partners, Ontario Association of Fire Chiefs, and Office of the Fire Marshall field advisor
- Fire Prevention Officer quarterly meeting regular fire inspections ongoing, several inspection orders created, high majority of voluntary compliance in TC, will liaison w/Pub Ed committee planning for support
- Joint-Station Committees formed inaugural meetings (first quarter)
 - Health and Wellness scheduling mental health peer support, Critical Incident Stress Management training – decontamination mitigation equipment ordered (cancer/disease prevention) – physical wellness initiatives explored
 - Truck and Equipment capital equipment research and purchases, apparatus replacement schedule review, asset management tracking initiated, researching equipment needs for future years
 - Public Education sponsorship a success for Inflatable Fire Safety House (arrival end of April), planning for school visits before summer, multiple fair and camp visits planned for the summer, planning smoke/CO alarm door to door campaigns for the fall
 - Training following curriculum for Firefighter certification training at regular practices (exam dates planned for September), many other staff attending other certification courses for Officer, Instructor, Pub Ed, Specialty Rescue, etc at Elgin/Middlesex training centre, joining local FDs for live fire training in Thamesford in May (several FFs attending), Planning joint training initiatives for remainder of '24, into '25
