Middlesex County Budget 2024



The 2024 Budget reflects the County commitment to making appropriate investments in the core services that our residents rely on, while also considering the reality that our taxpayers are facing increased costs of living from provincial and federal policy decisions.

A tax rate increase of 2.93% means that for the value of a residential property, taxes would increase by \$12.62 per \$100,000 of the value of the property according to its MPAC assessment.




