ACTIVITIES:

- Direction given to 9 full-time and 2 part-time staff
- Responded to numerous inquiries, completed invoicing, filing, timesheets, record-keeping, emails, salesman
- Continuous routine maintenance of Transportation section of Fleet
- Removal of half load signage throughout the Municipality
- Spring street sweeping completed
- Sod damage repairs from winter operations complete
- Assisted Community Services with hauling and application of diamond clay on Frost Field in Harrietsville
- Shoulder work along hard surface roads completed
- Annual maintenance gravel completed
- Annual dust control completed
- Asphalt prep work required prior to hard surface treatment completed
- Hard Surface Treatment completed
- Purple Hill Road gravel conversion completed
- Hot Mix Asphalt project has begun
- Sidewalk installation and boulevard restoration on Hamilton Road just east of Queen Street completed
- Assisting Environmental Services with sidewalk replacement following water service leaks along Catherine Street complete
- Tree removed on Cromarty Drive just east of Elgin Rd complete
- First pass of roadside mowing completed; second pass begins
- Assisting Environmental Services with removal of compost from Landfill
- Placement of mobile speed radar sign in various locations throughout the Municipality
- Annual Gravel Pit compliance inspections completed
- Traffic counting of municipal roads has begun
