- Attended Canadian Emergency Preparedness and Climate Adaptation Convention
- FF Health and Wellness Committee attended Resilient Minds training and met with County colleagues to engage in County-Wide CISM (Critical Incident Stress Management) program dialogue
- Firefighter Certification Exams completed in September. Majority of Firefighters now certified to NFPA 1001, Levels 1&2. Certification courses continuing – HAZMAT and PUMP Operations, as well as Officer and Instructor training. Thank you to Training Officers and Committee for assisting in exam preparation.
- Public Education Committee attended multiple events this summer, increasing our presence in the community, spreading fire and public safety awareness to residents. Fire Safety House utilized multiple times across the municipality.
- Applied for Project Zero and Provincial Fire Protection Grants – awards pending
- Introduced new Firefighter Identification badge numbering, reflecting station assignments
- Implemented several new operational Policies and Operating Guidelines
- TCFD Car 1 (Fire Chief's Truck) placed into service.
- Equipment Delivery of Firefighter PPE, Auto Extrication hydraulic pump and cutters, Firefighting coveralls, etc.
- Station 2's Heavy Rescue truck nearing completion – Mid-point and final inspections expected next quarter. Potential delivery Q1 of 2025.
- Planning recruitment for Q4, with Open House and interviews taking place
