

# THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THAMES CENTRE

## BY-LAW NO. 56-2025

---

Being a By-law to appoint a Deputy Treasurer for The Corporation of the Municipality of Thames Centre.

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, Section 286(2) provides that a municipality may appoint a deputy treasurer who shall have all the powers and duties of the treasurer under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 286(6) provides that the treasurer may continue to exercise the delegated powers and duties, despite the delegation;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Thames Centre deems it expedient to appoint a Deputy Treasurer;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Thames Centre **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** Blaine Lucas is hereby appointed Deputy Treasurer of the Municipality of Thames Centre, under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, subject to the direction of the Treasurer, who shall have all the powers of the Treasurer under the *Municipal Act* or any other Act.
2. **THAT** the said Blaine Lucas, shall perform all of the duties required to be performed by the Deputy Treasurer under any statutory authority, and any other duties that may be imposed by the Council of the Municipality of Thames Centre for municipal business.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect on the day that it is passed.

**READ** a **FIRST** and **SECOND** time this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2025.

**READ** a **THIRD** time and **FINALLY PASSED** this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2025.
