

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THAMES CENTRE

BY-LAW NO. 114-2023

Being a By-law to authorize the execution of a Temporary Use Agreement with Shelley Hunter relating to the property at Part of Lot 18, Concession 7 (geographic Township of West Nissouri), now the Municipality of Thames Centre.

(Shelley Hunter – Temporary Use Agreement)

WHEREAS Section 39.1 of the *Planning Act, RSO 1990, c. P.13*, authorizes municipalities to enter into temporary use agreements;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality deems it expedient and advisable to enter into an Agreement regarding the temporary use of the Lands which is enforceable pursuant to section 442 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended;

AND WHEREAS a copy of the said Temporary Use Agreement with Shelley Hunter and The Corporation of the Municipality of Thames Centre is attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Thames Centre **ENACTS** as follows:

1. **THAT** the entering into a Temporary Use Agreement with Shelley Hunter is hereby approved and authorized.
2. **THAT** the Deputy Mayor and the Interim Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the Municipality of Thames Centre the said Temporary Use Agreement, in substantially the same form as that attached hereto and forming a part of this By-law.
3. **THAT** the Temporary Use Agreement shall take effect and come into force upon the signing thereof by all of the parties thereto.
4. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a FIRST and SECOND time, this 27th day of November, 2023.

READ a THIRD time and **FINALLY PASSED** this 27th day of November, 2023.
