RECOMMENDATION:

AND THAT Council approve the attached DRAFT Tree Planting Plan as further recommended by the Thames Centre Environmental Advisory Committee.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to present a DRAFT Tree Planting Plan for Council consideration.

BACKGROUND:

At its June 12, 2023 meeting, Thames Centre Council passed the following resolution:

THAT staff prepare a tree planting plan to support the World Economic Forum initiative to plant 1 trillion trees and further that the plan should include the following pillars:

- Community Involvement
- Native Trees
- Public and Private Involvement Protection of Existing Trees
- Identifying Heritage Trees
- Recognition of Indigenous respect for the natural world and rights of the Treaties

At its inaugural meeting on December 4, 2023, the Environmental Advisory Committee reviewed and discussed the DRAFT Tree Planting Plan and recommends approval as attached herein.



COMMENTS:

The attached DRAFT Tree Planting Plan is in response to the Council direction and attempts to put forward a realistic and doable vision of 50,000 trees planted within Thames Centre municipal boundaries, through partnerships, over 25 years.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Any financial implications associated with the adoption of this this draft plan will be brought forward during the annual budget approval process. The 2024 Draft budget identifies \$20,000 towards this initiative so that, if approved, the Tree Planting Plan can begin to be implemented in 2024.
