**AND THAT** Mr. M. P. Devos, of Spriet Associates, be appointed the Engineer to investigate and prepare the necessary drainage report.

### PURPOSE:

To provide Council with the necessary information to deal with the request under the Drainage Act.

### BACKGROUND:

On September 27, 2023, an onsite meeting was held regarding a request for drainage works with the potential to extend the existing Elliott Drain – Branch 'A'. After this meeting was complete the owner of the property directly west of the original petitioner who was in attendance, outlined their concerns relating to storm water around their property.

This current request is to address these concerns and potentially further extend the Elliott Drain – Branch 'A'.

### COMMENTS:

Providing the petitioner with a Municipal Drain outlet will ensure that their lands will have a properly managed and maintained storm outlet.
